

### PREFACE

This volume sees the completion of the fourth series, and is the eightieth volume of the *Proceedings* issued by the Society.

We have also to report the completion of the printing of the Saxon Charters of Somerset by Dr. G. B. Grundy, which has extended, in appendix form, over eight volumes (lxxiii—lxxx). The last instalment includes an index, title-page and introduction, so that members may, if they wish, have these sheets removed from their volumes and bound up separately. The work has its pagination

apart from the volume of Proceedings.
