# SOMERSET ARCHAEOLOGICAL AND NATURAL HISTORY SOCIETY

## ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2000

The Annual General Meeting of the Society was held at the Blue School, Wells, on Saturday 20th May 2000. The meeting was attended by 60 members of the Society and apologies for absence were received from a further fourteen.

Dr Robert Dunning welcomed members to the meeting. Dr Dunning thanked all those involved with the events of the Anniversary year. He mentioned in particular the Local History symposium, the Dillington Conference – with special thanks to Bob Croft, the Millennium book, and the forthcoming Garden Party in the Norman Garden.

The Chairman thanked the Honorary Editor, Michael McGarvie, in his absence and reported that Mr Peter Ellis would take over as Editor with effect from volume 142. Members who had died in the past year included a former Editor, Kenneth Hudson. Audrey West who had produced the Newsletter for the last couple of years wished to hand over to someone after producing the Autumn issue. The Chairman asked for volunteers.

On his retirement as Chairman after four years, Dr Dunning thanked the Chairmen of committees and the Honorary Librarian, David Bromwich, the Treasurer, Keith Jackson, and the Administrative Secretary, Betty Cloke. The Right Reverend Jim Thompson, Bishop of Bath and Wells, was thanked for his services as President during the year 1999–2000.

The Report and Accounts for the year ended 31st December 1999 were presented by the Honorary Treasurer and adopted. The Chairmen of the Archaeology, Historic Buildings, Library, Local History, Natural History, and House Committees gave reports about their activities during the year. The County Museums Officer gave his report. This was followed by a report from Mrs Madge Langdon, the Administrator of the Maltwood Fund, on the grants made available during the year.

The following officers were elected: Honorary Editor – Michael McGarvie; Honorary Librarian – David Bromwich; Honorary Treasurer – Keith Jackson. Mrs Anita Sims was elected to Council for the period 2000–2003, and Mr Alexander Maxwell Findlater for the period 2000–2001. Mrs Barbara Lowe, Stephen Minnitt, and Tony Setterington were re-elected, to serve until 2003.

Messrs Albert Goodman were elected as Independent Examiners of the Society's Accounts and Mr C. Palmer as Honorary Legal Consultant, as were members of the subject committees.

Dr Robert Dunning gave a report on the current work of the Somerset Record Society.

The business meeting was followed by the Presidential Address given by the retiring President, the Right Reverend Jim Thompson, on Bishop Thomas Ken, looking at three facets of his life – his integrity, the centrality of his prayers, and his love of the church.

The Bishop then announced that Dr Dunning would be President for 2000-2001.
