

NATURAL HISTORY RECORDERS' NOTES  
VASCULAR PLANTS 1979

The name of each species is preceded by its number in J. E. Dandy, *List of British Vascular Plants* (1958) and in Dandy's subsequent revision, *Watsonia*, 7, 157—158 (1971). The vice-county, 5 or 6, is indicated, followed in brackets by the number of the District, one of ten into which Somerset was divided by R. P. Murray in his *Flora of Somerset* (1896). Following the locality is the ten-kilometre National Grid square, and the name of the contributor. New vice-county and district records are marked\* and aliens†.
