

SOMERSET COUNTY MUSEUMS SERVICE

1987 ACCESSIONS

The practice of annually listing accessions to Somerset County Museum, or its equivalent predecessor, in the *Proceedings*, which had been continuous from Volume 1 in 1851, lapsed following Volume 114 for 1969/70. At the request of the County Museums Officer, the annual listings are being revived, and now include additions to the collections of the Somerset Rural Life Museum at Glastonbury as well as the County Museum. Anybody wishing to inspect any of the objects listed is requested to make an appointment with the appropriate Keeper, and to quote the accession number(s). Most of the social history collections are dealt with at Glastonbury; all other inquiries should be addressed to the County Museum at Taunton Castle or the Museum Education Service at Weir Lodge, 83 Staplegrove Road, Taunton, as appropriate.
