SANHS was founded in 1849 and purchased Taunton Castle in 1873 to save the historic site for the County of Somerset. The castle houses the Museum of Somerset, which incorporates many of the artefacts collected by the Society for over 150 years. Next to the castle is Wyndham Hall. Built in 1927, it was donated to the Society by the Wyndham family. Today SANHS is based in Somerset Heritage Centre in Taunton, where it can care for its priceless collection of books, prints and manuscripts which have been collected and donated by its members.

As a member of SANHS you will receive a copy of the Society's annual publication Proceedings, which contains articles and reports of work undertaken in Somerset, by a wide variety of organisations and individuals, relating to the objects of the Society. SANHS members pay a concessionary entry fee to the Rural Life Museum in Glastonbury.
