F O R E W O R D

THE compilation of a full index to the *Proceedings* of the Somersetshire Archaeological and Natural History Society has long been contemplated by the Council, but no one has been found to undertake the task voluntarily, and the expense of having the work done by a professional is considered prohibitive.

The Council still hopes that some day a full index will be compiled and published, but in the meanwhile Prebendary G. W. Saunders has kindly allowed the Editorial Committee to utilize the index he had made for his own purposes. This is a short index, chiefly topographical. The cost of publication is being defrayed by a private gift, and copies will be presented to members of the Society.

Thanks are due to Prebendary Saunders for the loan of his index, and to Mr. Vivian-Neal and Mr. B. W. Taylor for the preparation and completion of the MS., and also to Mr. Vivian-Neal and Mr. St. George Gray for the index to the Inventory of Somerset Church Plate which is added as a supplement.

Special attention is called to Dr. Fryer's papers on Monumental Effigies, an index to which has already been published, and to Mr. Bligh Bond's articles on Church Screens, Dr. Allen's articles on Church Towers and the articles on Church Dedications, to none of which topographical references are given in this index.
