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PREFACE

General Headings

Much of the material in this index has been gathered into the following general headings which appear in bold type: Agriculture, Archaeology, Architecture, Churches, Climate, Communications, Courts, Ecclesiastical, Engineering, Geology, Heraldry, Medical, Military, Mines and Minerals, Natural History, Numismatics, Politics, Social History, Trades and Industry. Similar chronological headings include: Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, Neolithic, Bronze Age, Iron Age, Roman and Romano-British, Dark Ages, Anglo-Saxon, Norman, Mediaeval, Post-Mediaeval.

Personal names

Variations in the spelling of personal names provide a subject in themselves outwith the scope of this work. While the variations of some well-known names have been collated or cross-referenced generally the form used has been that adopted by the author of the paper concerned. The user who is not immediately successful in finding the name sought should therefore try possible alternatives before concluding that the person is not mentioned.

The user is further advised that an entry such as "Smith, John, **82** 27, **94** 63, **101** 17" may refer to one person, or to three or more unrelated individuals, though efforts have been made to separate different persons of the same name where the evidence is clear.

General

References in footnotes are only recorded where there is no reference in the main body of the page.

The great variations in length, style and subject matter of the contents of these 33 volumes have hindered a classical uniformity in the presentation of the entries. It is hoped however that the methods adopted have not obscured the information available and that, though the compiler must inevitably have nodded more often than Homer, such merits as this work may have will pardon its shortcomings.
